**BBC:** A simple journey for sighted people, but John takes his life in his own hands whenever he leaves home.

**John:** I try to remember to turn my head when I'm thinking about crossing the road, so the drivers have some idea of my intentions, and they don't just think ( ① ).

**BBC:** Only one person helps him on his 20-minute walk. For John and two million other blind and partially sighted people<sup>\*1</sup> in the UK, simple measures<sup>\*2</sup> would dramatically improve their safety.

**John:** I was walking along this platform, and because there is no tactile paving<sup>\*3</sup>, I had to follow the edge of the platform and I slipped on some oil, and because I was close to the edge, I ended up on the track<sup>\*4</sup>.

**BBC:** Since John broke his legs, arms and shoulder, there have been some improvements but not enough. Not all platforms have these safety features, which is one of the many reasons why six out of ten blind and partially sighted people are not prepared to go out on their own. ( ② ) things improve, it's only a matter of time before someone dies.
